



# Town map of Cham with sites related to the local Jewish history

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- 1 The prayer room of the Jewish community was on the second floor of a former restaurant from 1895 to 1938 and from 1945 to the mid-1970s. Since 1991 the building is used by a junior high school.
- 2 At the front of the medieval town hall there is a gravestone from the Jewish cemetery in Regensburg.

- 3 The former location of the department store of Samuel Neuburger.
- 4 Isaak Lazarus Boscowitz ran his textiles' shop in this building till 1881. His successor was the Jewish shopkeeper Moritz Stern.
- 5 It is said that the medieval synagogue and the Jewish school were in the area of today's "Judenstrasse" (Jews' lane), which refers to the former ghetto.
- 6 The first location of the shoe department store of Benjamin Eisfeld.
- 7 The location of Gustav Bloch's clothes' shop.
- 8 In the eastern part of the town is the "Dr.-Karl-Stern-Straße". A couple of years ago the town's council decided on the naming of this street after a former Jewish citizen, the renown Canadian psychiatrist Dr. Stern.

The Jewish cemetery is several kilometers remote from the town's center in the country site.
