


Town map of Cham with sites related to the local **Jewish history**

- 1 The prayer room of the Jewish 2 At the front of the medieval town community was on the second floor of a former restaurant from 1895 to 1938 and from 1945 to the mid-1970s. Since 1991 the building is used by a junior high school.

- 7 The location of Gustav Bloch's 8 In the eastern part of the town is clothes' shop.
 - "Dr.-Karl-Stern-Straße". A the couple of years ago the town's council decided on the naming of this street after a former Jewish citizen, the renown Canadian psychiatrist Dr. Stern.

The Jewish cemetery is several kilometers remote from the town's center in the country site.
