Funerals and graves at the Jewish cemetery in Ermershausen (Lower Franconia)

The source

Much to my surprise I found a source for the Jewish genealogy of Lower Franconia in the holdings of Nuremberg City Archives (NCA), because basically the competence of NCA is limited to the municipal area. Though the provenance of the following records (registration no. E 39 1339/5,6) is not quite clear to me - maybe a local researcher or the respective Jewish congregation -, their informational contents are substantial and beyond any doubt:

- 1) The typed copy of a letter from December 19, 1840, written to the saddler M.W. Sachs in Marold-sweisach by the Jewish teacher of religious education Jacob Salzer in nearby Ermershausen. In his introduction Salzer gives the background story otherwise not obvious to the reader: At the time Sachs worked on a register and asked his friend and correspondent in Ermershausen to compile the funerals during the previous ten years in a list.
- 2) An anonymous list of the graves on the Jewish cemetery in Ermershausen. Both the copy of Salzer's letter and this list are written on the same typewriter using carbon paper. The last entries in list 2 are from September 1935, which makes the fall of 1935 the most plausible date of thar four page compilation.

I decided to include the English translation into the *RIJO* web site, because I could neither find an edited version of Sachs' register nor of the graves' listing. In the latter case I doubt the completeness of the list for it only contains dates of death from the 1830s, 1840s and 1930s.

Basic information on the Jewish cemetery in Ermershausen

The Jewish cemetery of Ermershausen (Hassberge district, Lower Franconia, Bavaria, 33 km northeast of Schweinfurt, 25 km southwest of Coburg) is situated at the road from Ermershausen to Maroldsweisach (also Hassberge district). It had been the burial place for Jews from both villages and today is well maintained.

Principles of the edition

All information of the typed lists had been transferred into this online version. The German spelling of the names as well as the terminology of the Jewish calendar (months, holidays) were not altered or in any way adapted in order to avoid mistakes by misinterpretation (I am no Hebrew calendar expert).

- "Hachower" obviously is the German transcription of the Hebrew "ha-Chaver".
